1. political map- maps that show borders between states and countries.

2. <u>title-</u> tells what a map is about (name of the map)

3. **<u>symbols-</u>** lines, small drawings, or fields of color that stand for something else on a map

4. <u>key-</u> a small box that explains the symbols on a map, also known as a legend

5. locator- a small map in a box or circle

6. **<u>physical maps-</u>** shows the major landforms and water on an area of the Earth's surface

7. <u>compass rose-</u> a design with four pointers that show the cardinal directions

8. <u>cardinal directions-</u> one of the four main directions- north, south, east, and west

9. <u>intermediate directions</u>- directions in between cardinal directionsnortheast, southeast, northwest and southwest

10. <u>scale</u>- a set of lines marked off in miles and kilometers that allows you to estimate the actual distance between points on a map.

11. <u>inset-</u> a small map in a box that is set inside a main map that shows details about the main map

12. <u>time zone map-</u> a map that shows the whole world's or any regions time zones

13. <u>elevation map-</u> a map that shows the height of land above sea level

14. <u>climate map-</u> a map that shows the climate (weather over a long period of time) of an area

15. **road map-** a special map that shows automobile routes between towns and cities for a region, county, state, or country
