- 1. Why is soil important? (page 316) Soil is important because without it, plants and animals would not be able to live on land.

3. Name and describe 2 ways to conserve soil. (Page 320) -<u>Fertilization-</u> add to soil to replace nutrients

-<u>Crop Rotation</u>- The planting of different crops in different years

- strip farming-plant grass between rows of other crops

<u>-contour plowing</u>-farmers plow furrows across a hill/slope to prevent rainwater from carrying soil down hills

-<u>terracing</u>-farmers cut shelves into a hillside to prevent rainwater from carrying soil down hills

-<u>wind breaks</u>-farmers plant tall trees to prevent the wind from carrying the soil away

-laws- governments pass laws to stop pollution

-<u>individual efforts</u>- stop polluting and help clean up land that is polluted

-<u>education</u>- inform people about the value of soil and how to conserve it
