Chapter 6 Lesson 2 Soil

- 1. <u>Soil</u> mixture of bits of rock and bits of once-living parts of plants and animals
- 2. Soil horizon a layer of soil
- 3. <u>Humus</u> the part of soil that is made of decayed parts of plants and animals, contains nutrients that feed plants, soaks up and holds water more easily than bits of rock
- 4. **Topsoil** the dark, top layer of soil, rich in humus and minerals, in which organisms live and most plants grow
- 5. **Pollution** the addition of harmful materials to the soil, air, or water
- 6. <u>**Conservation</u>** saving, protecting, or using natural resources wisely</u>

Summary:

- Soil is a mixture of bits of rocks and once living parts of plants and animals
- Soil supports plant and animal life and can be polluted
- Soil can be conserved in many ways
