Chapter 6 Lesson 3 Fossils and Energy

- 1. **Fossil** any remains or imprints of living things from the past
- 2. <u>Fossil fuel</u> a fuel formed from the decay of ancient organisms and is used today as a source of energy
- 3. **Relative age** the age of one rock or fossil when compared to another
- 4. **Absolute age** a rock or fossil's age in years
- 5. **Era** long stretches of time used to measure Earth's geological history
- 6. **Nonrenewable resource** a resource that can not be replaced within a short period of time or at all
- 7. Renewable resource a resource that can be replanted or replaced naturally in a short period of time
- 8. <u>Alternative energy source</u> any source of energy other than the burning of fossil fuels
