- 1. geologist a scientist who examines rocks to find out about Earth's history and structure
- 2. <u>plate tectonics</u> a theory used to explain how forces underground cause the continents to move
- 3. magma hot melted rock below Earth's surface
- 4. <u>faults</u> deep cracks in Earth's crust
- 5. <u>Pangaea</u> scientists have concluded that millions of years ago, South America and Africa were once a part of this supercontinent.
- 6. <u>compression</u> squeezing or pushing together of the crust
- 7. continents- large land masses
- 8. <u>shear</u> a force that twists, tears, or pushes one part of the crust past another
- 9. <u>continental drift</u> Wegner's theory that continents are slowly drifting apart
- 10. Fossil remains or signs of a once-living thing
